FALLING LEAF BLANKET

by Seed Stitcher Michele Bonner

Use worsted weight yarn. Great stashbuster.

Leaf

Cast on 3 sts.

ROW 1: k1, yo, k1, yo, k1.

ROW 2 AND ALL EVEN ROWS P.

ROW 3: K2, yo, k1, yo, k2.

ROW 5: K3, yo, k1, yo, k3.

ROW 7: K4, yo, k1, yo, k4.

ROW 9: K5, yo, k1, yo, k5.

ROW 11: K6, yo, k1, yo, k6.

ROW 13: K7, yo, k1, yo, k7.

ROW 15: Knit

ROW 17: SSK k to last 2 sts, k2tog.

Repeat until 3sts left on needles. SSK, k2tog.

Make as many leaves as you need for the size blanket, sew all together, then knit edging to fit length of perimeter.

Scalloped Leaf Edging

Cast on 8 sts.

ROW 1: (RS) K5, yo, k1, yo k2.

ROW 2: P6, inc 1, k3.

ROW 3: K4, p1, k2, yo, k1, yo, k3.

ROW 4: P8, inc 1, k4.

ROW 5: K4, p2, k3, yo, k1, yo, k4.

ROW 6: P10, inc 1, k5.

ROW 7: K4, p3, k4, yo, k1, yo, k5.

ROW 8: P12, inc 1, k6 - 20 sts.

ROW 9: K4, p4, ssk, k7, k2tog, k1.

ROW 10: P10, inc 1, k7.
